


Prevent Child Strangulation

#GoCordless with Window Coverings

On average, about **9 children** under 5 years of age **die every year from strangling in window blinds**, shades, draperies and other window coverings with cords.



There have been over **200 incidents** involving children up to 8 years old **due to strangulation hazards from window covering cords**.*



Injuries varied from a scar around the neck, quadriplegia, and permanent brain damage.

What happened to the children?



What to do? Go Cordlessthe safest option.

- Buy and install cordless window coverings, which are available at most major retailers.
- When buying online, make sure the product is described as cordless.
